



ANNUAL BEACH PARKING LOT PERMIT RULES & REGULATIONS

By purchasing the Annual Beach Parking Lot Permit you agree to abide by the permit rules and regulations.

**Permit is a virtual non-transferable permit assigned to the vehicle's license plate.
Physical permit will NOT be issued.**

RATES: \$100 City of Oceanside resident (vehicle must be registered to a City of Oceanside residential address)
\$200 non-resident

EXPIRATION: Permit expires **on the last day of the month one-year from the date of purchase** (i.e. purchased 6/15/22, expires 6/30/23). There is no grace period. Expired permits will receive a parking citation. A valid email address must be provided to receive account notifications; including renewal and expiration notifications. The City is not responsible for non-receipt of notifications.

- **Current vehicle registration required.**
 - Vehicle registration address must match the account holder's address.
 - Incomplete or expired vehicle registrations will not be accepted. DMV renewal notice will not be accepted.
 - Permit will not be issued for trailers or for storage of commercial vehicles.
 - **Permit is electronically assigned to the license plate of the vehicle registration.** Vehicle's license plate must be displayed pursuant to the applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code.
 - Permit will not be issued until the buyer has cleared all outstanding parking citations.
- Each permit may be assigned **up to two vehicles that are registered to the same address** as the account holder. **Permit may only be used by one assigned vehicle at time.** Account holder is responsible for maintaining the vehicle(s) assigned to the permit; including license plate changes. - Government issued ID (i.e. driver's license) matching the vehicle registration is required for in-person permit purchases.
- Permits are valid in most City and Harbor pay parking lots (see map) during posted parking lot hours only. Posted time limits, time closures, and lot rules are strictly enforced.
 - **Permits are not valid in marked slip renter/boat permit parking in Harbor lots.**
 - **Permits are not valid at street parking meters.**
 - **Permits are not valid at pay lot parking meters.**
 - **Permits are not valid during posted special events.**
 - **Permits are not valid for overnight parking.** Lots 11A, 11B, 12, and 26 will require the additional overnight fee.
- Permits are **non-refundable.** Permit costs will not be refunded due to intermittent/permanent lot closures or permit holder's inability to utilize the permit.
- **A parking citation will be issued** to vehicles not assigned a valid permit, vehicle's license plate not clearly displayed, non-compliance with the permit program's rules and regulations, or non-compliance with parking enforcement laws. **Citations will not be dismissed or reduced.**
- The City reserves the right to make changes to the Annual Beach Parking Lot Permit Program including, but not limited to, the validity of the permit in specific lots, the availability of parking lots and spaces, and/or parking lot restrictions after permit issuance. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to contact the City for updates.
